



Here is your packing list for Camp Gattawanna!

Please understand, this is camp! Your camper, and their clothes will get messy.
Do not send your camper's "Sunday Best" clothes, they may get dirty, or destroyed!
We also can not be responsible for lost items at camp!
Labelling things is encouraged especially their towels.

Please send the following items with your camper. Check it off when you got it in the bag!

Clothing:

- Old Clothes (that can get ruined)
- Flip Flops
- Pajamas
- Underwear
- A laundry Bag for dirty and wet clothing. (there are clothes lines for drying towels and swim suits)
- Proper fitting Swim Trunks that stay up for boys
- Modest Bathing Suit for girls - Tankinis must touch top of bottoms : (Please no bikinis)
- T-shirts
- Tennis shoes
- Light Rain Jacket
- Shorts
- Swim Shoes (recommended)
- Compression Shorts

Toiletries and Bath:

- Toiletries Bag
- Deodorant
- Toothbrush & Toothpaste
- Ziploc Baggies
- 2 Towels. (one for shower, one for lake)
- Hairbrush or Comb
- Washcloth or Loofa
- Shampoo & Conditioner
- Personal Hygiene Items
- Baby Powder for Chafing
- Sunscreen
- Soap
- Hair ties
- Feminine Products

Bedding (the cabins are air conditioned and comfortable):

- Pillow
- Sheets
- Blanket or Sleeping bag

And, very importantly, please remember:

- Bible
- Flashlight
- Pens & Pencils
- Bug Spray

** If your child needs medication during the week, please put all medications in 2 (two) personalized pill boxes, labeled "AM" and "PM".

Medication will be taken at the start of camp and administered under staff supervision.



Again, we can not be responsible for lost items at camp!

Do Not Send the following items with your camper (or allow them to bring):

Cell Phones, Ipods or Mp3 players, Secular Music, or Electronic Games

There is no need to send a phone as there is little to no cell service at the campground.

Do not send Food - Food and snacks are not allowed in cabins. (It attracts ants, bugs and rodents!)

We will feed your camper like royalty and they will have ample snacks and water throughout the day!

Very important: Do not send or allow your camper to bring the following:

Alcohol, Tobacco Products, Illegal Drugs, Practical Joke Items or Fireworks!

Campers with these items will be dismissed from camp.

Do not send Money. Camper's fees pay for everything including "Tuck Shop" *

*(Tuck Shop is Canadian for Canteen or Snack Shack).
